Board Memo 059-2021: USPS Posts Hundreds of EAS-17 Supervisor Positions for All to Apply

Executive Board,

During the recent 2a and 2b RIF EAS postings, approximately 900 EAS-17 supervisor positions were posted in eCareer. These positions went unfilled. Therefore, USPS consulted with NAPS that in the next round of EAS postings that all career postal employees (craft, EAS and RIF impacted EAS) may apply for vacant EAS-17 supervisor positions in customer service, plant, transportation, and maintenance to ensure there is sufficient supervisory staffing prior to Peak Season. NAPS agreed, as RIF impacted EAS may continue to apply for these vacant supervisor positions.

Supervisor positions available

To prepare for the upcoming peak season, the Postal Service plans to fill about 900 (“nine hundred”) Level 17 supervisor positions.

These will be Executive and Administrative Schedule — also known as “E-A-S” — positions and the Postal Service will accept applications for them from Tuesday, August 17, through Monday, August 23.

The positions will include the following:

- Supervisor, Customer Service Support;
- Supervisor, Customer Services;
- Supervisor, Distribution Operations;
- Supervisor, Transportation Operations; and
- Supervisor, Maintenance Operations.

All eligible nonbargaining and bargaining unit employees can apply for these jobs, including those affected by the ongoing administrative restructuring.

To apply for these positions, log into LiteBlue using your employee identification number and password.

Next, select eCareer and click the “Search and/or Apply for EAS Jobs” heading to search and apply for open positions.

Make sure your eCareer Profile is up to date before submitting any applications.
