As a matter of general interest, the Postal Service will be displaying various information on monitors in the work area of post offices. This initiative is called Informed Facility.

The information has several purposes. It is a central location of customizable communication. It also serves as a digital center for employee engagement and recognition. Sites are also able to customize their screens to represent their office and the communities they serve. In addition, we are able to display real-time carrier data and sorting machine throughput numbers. These metrics already existed, however the ability to share this data with employees was limited. IF conveys this information in a unified format. The data updates periodically and the information streams constantly.

WORK INSTRUCTION: SPM DELIVERY

Service Performance Measurement (SPM) is the measurement of speed and reliability of mail services. USPS measures letters, flats, and parcels from collection to delivery; determines service scores; and then applies the data to provide timely, reliable, accurate, and secure mail services to customers.

RECEIVE PROMPT

Carrier moves along route and receives MDD prompt. The MDD vibrates and generates audio alert chime and voice prompt.


02



INITIATE WORK ORDER

Work order appears, press enter to initiate work order. If you need to postpone scanning, press ESC to exit the work order. To retrieve the work order scroll to the bottom of the screen and click "W" to return to work orders.


03



CONFIRM ADDRESS

Confirm if address is on route. Confirming that this address is on your route will continue running SPM.


04



SCAN BARCODE(S)


Scan the barcodes of letters and flats ONLY for the address specified in the work order. Do NOT scan any mail that has been previously attempted delivery of, including but not limited to hold mail.

05



PRESS ENTER

Press enter when complete or if no pieces to scan. If additional pieces are there to scan, select option 1. If no mail pieces or no additional mail pieces need to be scanned, select option 2. If already delivered mail to address, select option 3.
