Dear Mr. Butts:

This general interest notification is to advise of the Postal Service's intent to expand zip code locations in the Sunday Hub delivery operations.

Specifically, Sunday delivery operations will be expanded by 2,393 zip codes across the nation. This expansion will be implemented in four phases. The first three phases consist of 784 zip codes that will be aligned with existing hubs across the country. In the fourth phase, the remaining 1609 zip codes will begin providing delivery service as soon as hubs and zip codes are decoupled for the 2022 Peak season.

The following is a breakdown of the number of zip codes being activated during the four-phase period:

- Phase 1 – 272 zip codes will be activated in the Southern Area effective June 5
- Phase 2 – 245 zip codes will be activated in the Central Area effective June 12
- Phase 3 – 267 zip codes will be activated in the Atlantic and WestPac Areas effective June 26
- Phase 4 – 1609 remaining zip codes will be activated nationwide during the Peak season, decouple to provide Sunday delivery
