This is a follow up to previous correspondence regarding the Postal Service conducting a proof-of-concept test concerning the use of mobile scanners by bargaining unit employees, in lieu of Hyper Electronic Badge Readers (HEBRs), to complete certain timekeeping entries. The most recent notice was dated April 4, 2023 (enclosed).

The use of scanners for timekeeping entries will be expanded to the Postal Vehicle Service (PVS) operation. Specifically, PVS drivers will use the TC77 scanner to make their required clock rings. The enhancement to the TC77 scanner will be piloted at the PVS operation in the following locations:

- Denver, Colorado Processing and Distribution Center (P&DC)
- Louisville, KY P&DC
- Syracuse, NY P&DC
- Tacoma, WA P&DC
- Athens, GA Sorting and Delivery Center (S&DC)

The PVS drivers are scheduled to begin using the mobile scanners for timekeeping entries on January 20.

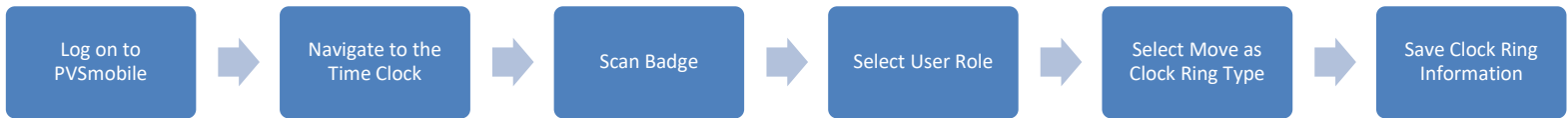

PVS Timekeeping

With the Beta deployment of SV Release 3.35 on Tuesday, January 16, 2024, PVSmobile has been enhanced to allow drivers to record their time from their PVSmobile scanner (this feature will be enabled on January 20). This can be accessed by selecting Time Clock from the home screen or the Navigation Menu on PVSmobile or when the driver attempts to log out of PVSmobile.

For Role Section, upon selecting Time Clock in PVSmobile, users will be prompted to scan their badge (Figure 1). They will then be prompted to select their role from the options of Full-Time, Part-Time, and Administrative (Figure 2).

After selecting their role, users will be prompted to select their clock ring type (Figure 3). Once the user selects Save, they will receive a confirmation pop-up notifying them that their selection and the time at which they saved their selection were recorded (Figure 4).

If a user accesses the Time Clock from the PVSmobile home screen or Navigation Menu and selects Move as their clock ring type, the user will receive an additional prompt to select and save an Operation ID (Figure 5). The clock ring selection will not be saved until they select an Operation ID (Figure 6).

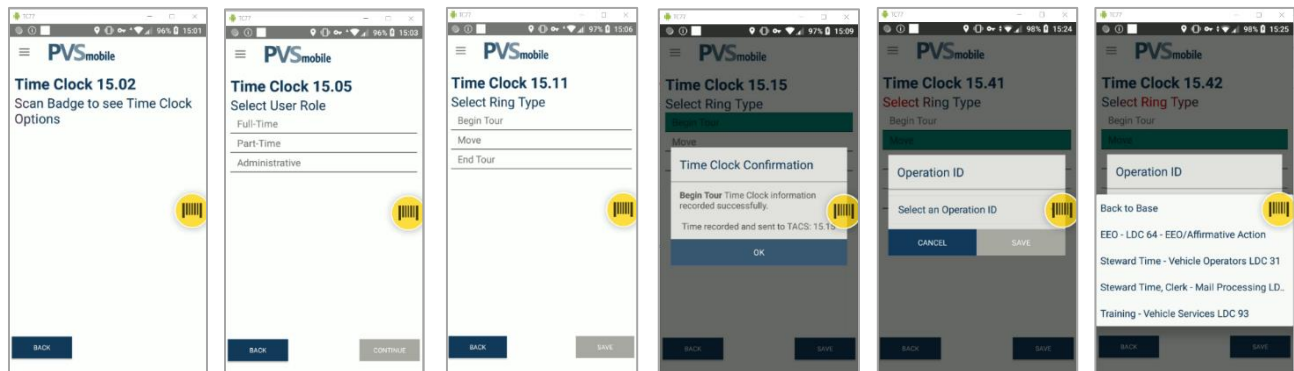

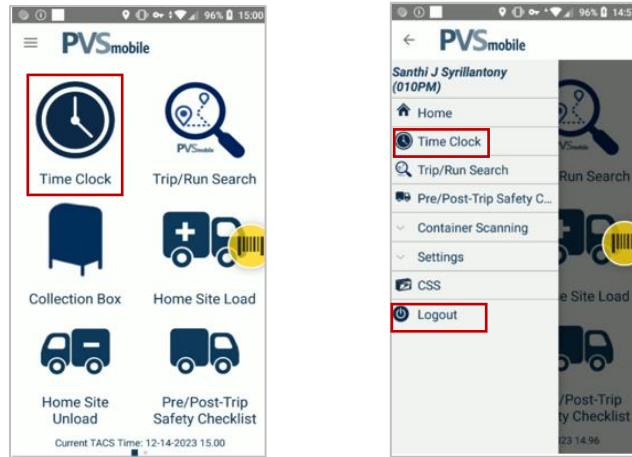
SV 3.35 Deployment

- PVS Timekeeping will become available to Beta sites on 1/20/2024.

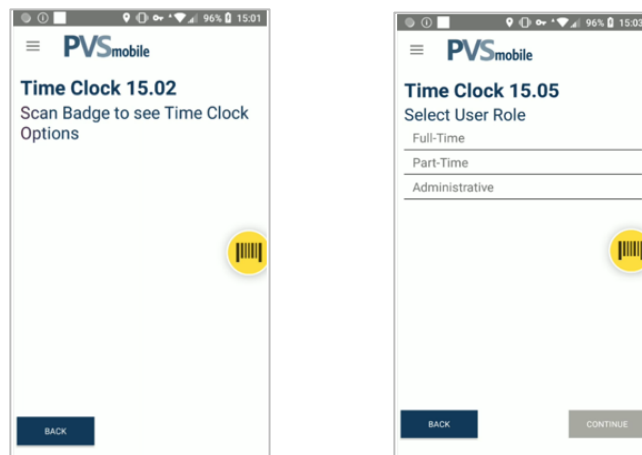
PVS Timekeeping

PVSmobile has been enhanced to allow drivers to record their time from their scanner. This can be accessed by selecting the Time Clock from the home screen or the navigation menu on PVSmobile or when the driver attempts to log out of PVSmobile.



Role Selection

Upon selecting Time Clock in PVSmobile, users will be prompted to scan their badge. They will then be prompted to select their role from the options of Full-Time, Part-Time, and Administrative.



Clock Ring Selection

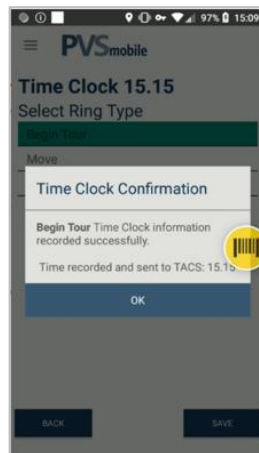
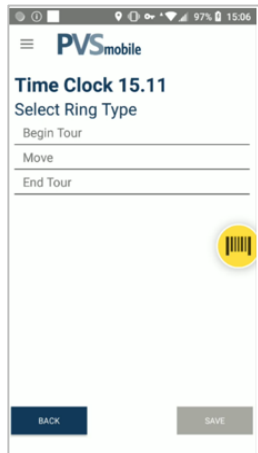
After selecting their role, users will be prompted to select their clock ring type. The below table shows the options available to the user based on what role they select if they access the Time Clock from either the home screen or the navigation menu:

Once the user selects Save, they will receive a confirmation pop-up notifying them that their selection and the TACS time at which they saved their selection were recorded.

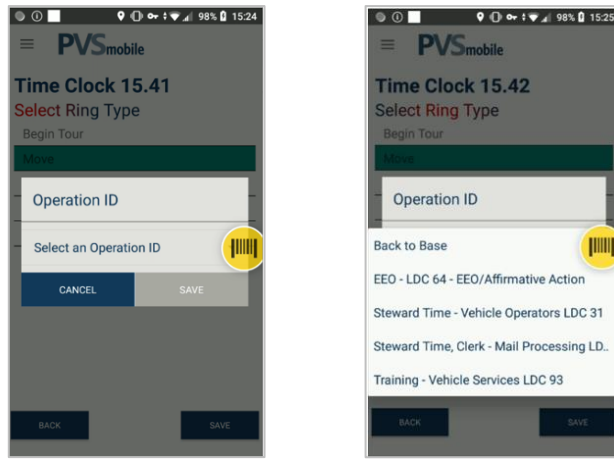


Move

If a user accesses the Time Clock from the PVSmobile home screen or navigation menu and selects Move as their clock ring type, the user will receive an additional prompt to select and save an Operation ID. They can select from the following options:

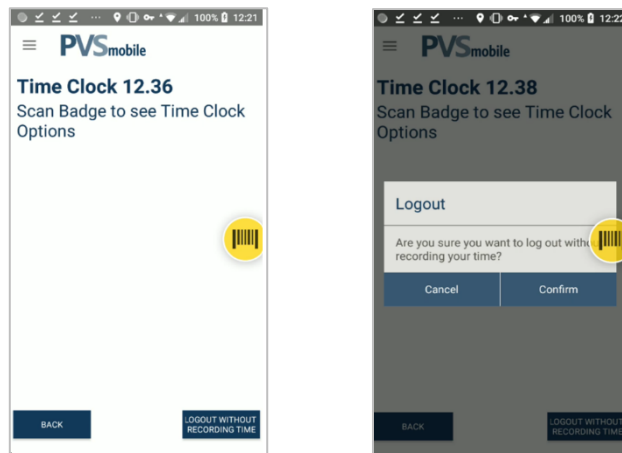
- Back to Base
- Stewards Time
- Steward Time, Clerk
- EEO
- Training - Vehicle Services

If Move is selected as the clock ring type, the clock ring selection will not be saved until they select Save on this additional prompt.



Logout Without Recording Time

When a user attempts to log out of PVSmobile, they will be navigated to the Time Clock and prompted to record their time before logging out. When the Time Clock is accessed this way, an additional button will be present on the clock ring selection screen titled “Logout Without Recording Time”, which gives users the option to log out of PVSmobile without recording their time. Upon selecting this button, the user will be prompted to confirm that they would like to log out of PVSmobile without recording their time. If the user selects Confirm, they will be logged out of PVSmobile.



Additional Updates

- **Route-Trip Information Column:** When a user accesses the Door Information page on SVweb, the Door Information table will now correctly display the Route-Trip Information column.
- **Duplicate Extra Trips:** Previously, there was an occasional issue where SV would allow for two extra trips with the same Route, Trip, and Operation Date to be created, causing the creation of duplicate extra trips. Now, the creation of duplicate extra trips will not be allowed by SV.
- **Missing Placard Barcodes on Handling Unit Scans Screen:** Previously, there was an occasional issue where barcodes for placards that were nested to and later consolidated would be missing from the table on the Handling Unit Scans screen within the SVweb Nesting Metrics page. Now, barcodes for placards that were nested to and later consolidated will correctly display on the Handling Unit Scans screen of the SVweb Nesting Metrics page.
- **Machines in Bin Status:** Previously, there was an occasional issue where machines with a bin range of 0-1 would not appear in the “Choose Location” dropdown in the Bin Status page on SVweb. Now, all machines with a bin range of 0-1 will appear in the dropdown.

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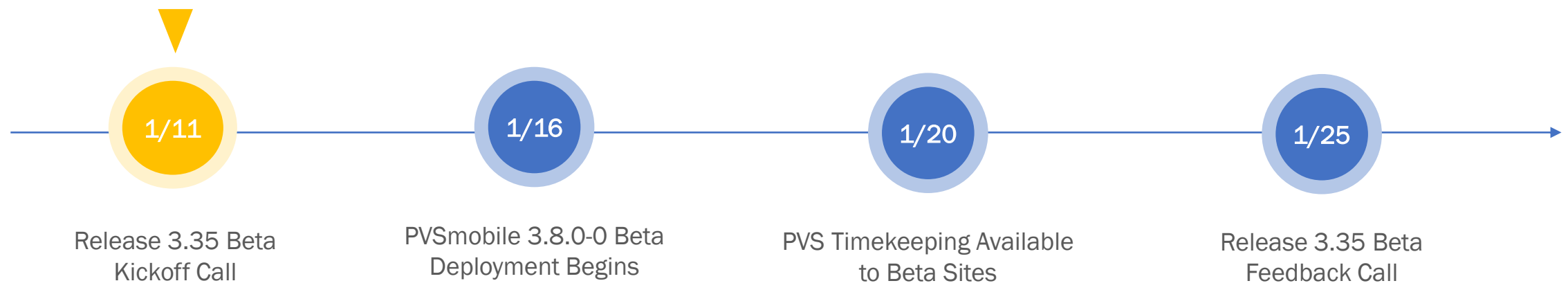
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SV Release 3.35 Deployment Timeline

Beta Test Site Overview

What is a Beta Test site?

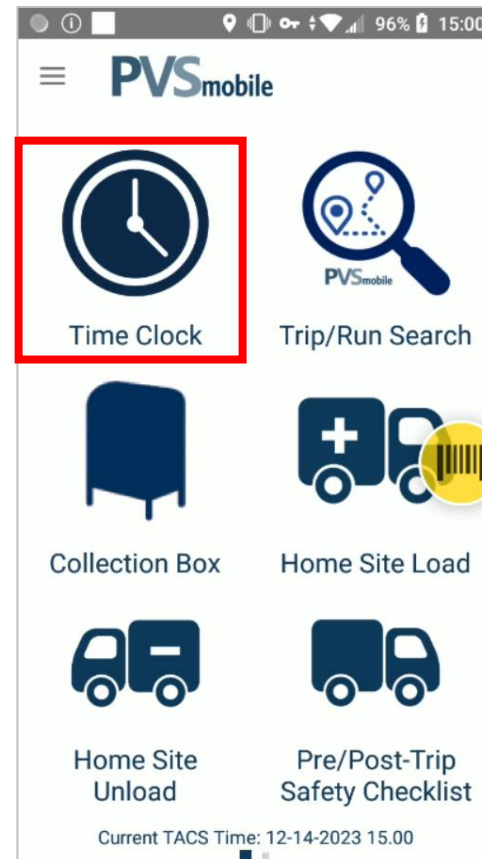
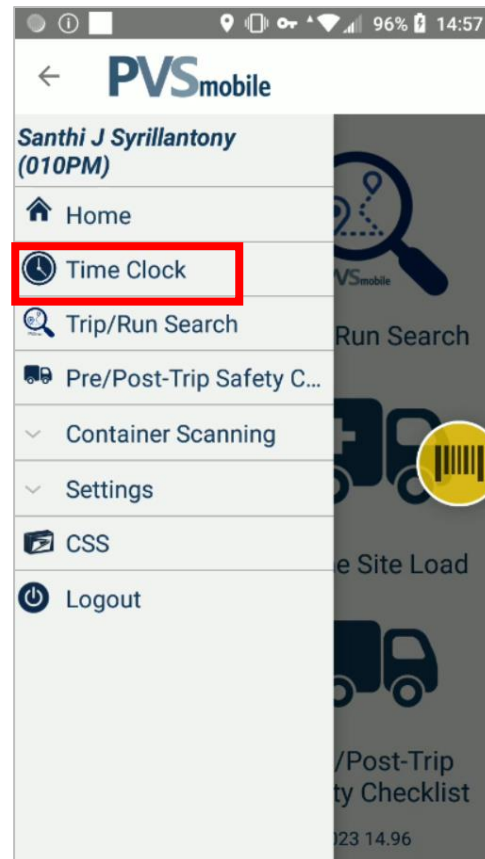
It is important to understand the value and importance of being a “Beta Test Site”. These are predetermined sites that will test new enhancements and upgraded functionality prior to these being deployed to all other sites nationally, so that any functionality issues can be detected and corrected prior to national deployment. Beta Test Sites are normally asked to remain a test site for three rounds of testing before a new group of test sites is determined.

What is the Beta Test site process?

- Beta Test Sites receive an invite to the “[Kick Off](#)” call.
- Beta Test Sites are required to have a minimum of one representative from their site attend the “Kick Off” call and can have as many representatives from their site as they would like
- Sites receive a “live” firsthand review of the new enhancement functionality and have a chance to ask questions related to the Release.
- Beta Test Sites then receive the enhancements and upgrades and all documentation related to the Release first, before it is released nationally to all sites.
- Beta Test Sites will then test the new functionality
- Beta Test Sites attend the “[Beta Feedback](#)” call, and should have a minimum of one site representative on the call
- Beta Test Sites report directly to the Team any encountered functionality issues, make suggestions for improvements, ask additional questions.

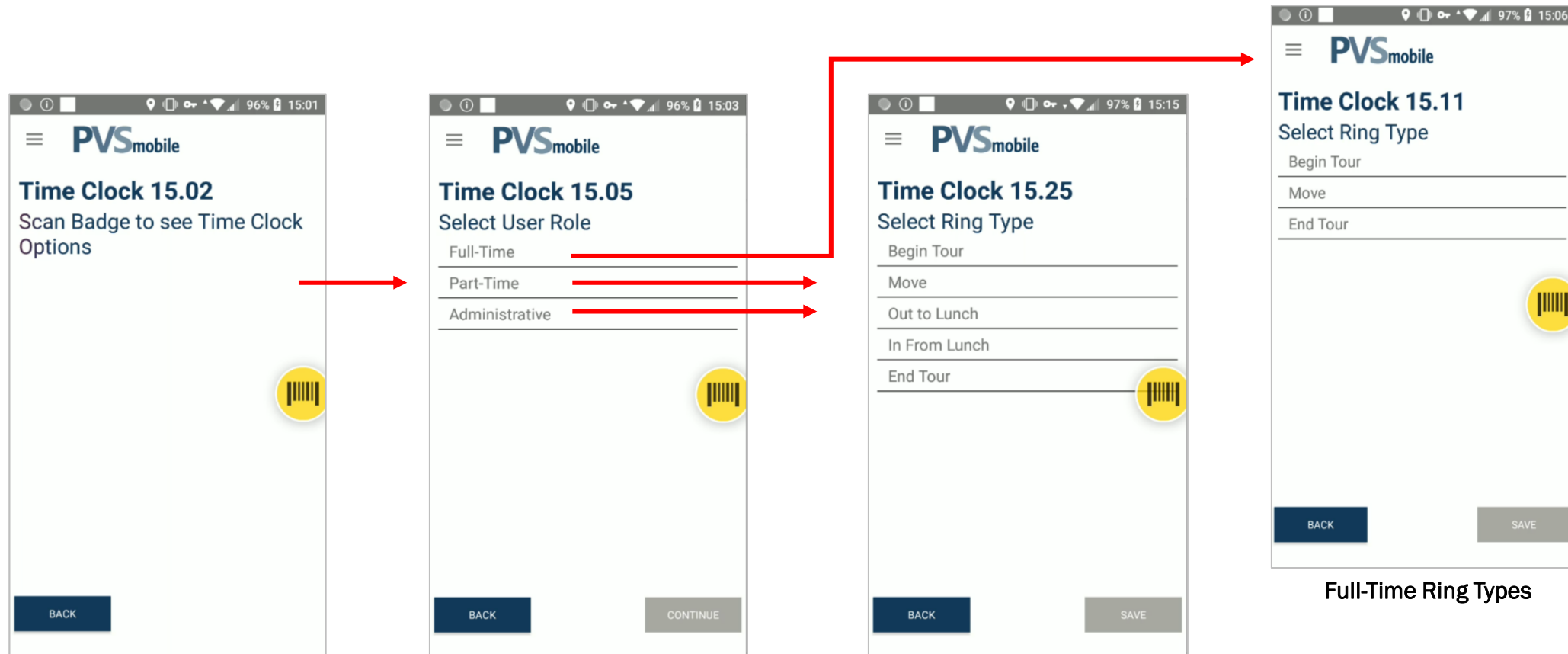
[NEW] PVS Timekeeping - Navigation

PVSmobile has been enhanced to now allow drivers to record their time from their scanner. The new Timekeeping feature can be accessed by selecting Time Clock from the home screen or the Navigation Menu on PVSmobile. It will also automatically open when a driver attempts to log out of PVSmobile.



[NEW] PVS Timekeeping – User Role and Ring Type

After logging into PVSmobile, users will see a Time Clock icon on the home screen. Time Clock can also be accessed from the Navigation Menu. When the user selects the Time Clock they will be prompted to scan their badge. The user will then select their role: either Full-Time, Part-Time, or Administrative. Depending on the selected role, various Ring Types will be available. ‘Begin Tour,’ ‘Move,’ and ‘End Tour’ are available for all user types. ‘Out to Lunch’ and ‘In from Lunch’ are available for Part-Time and Administrative Users.



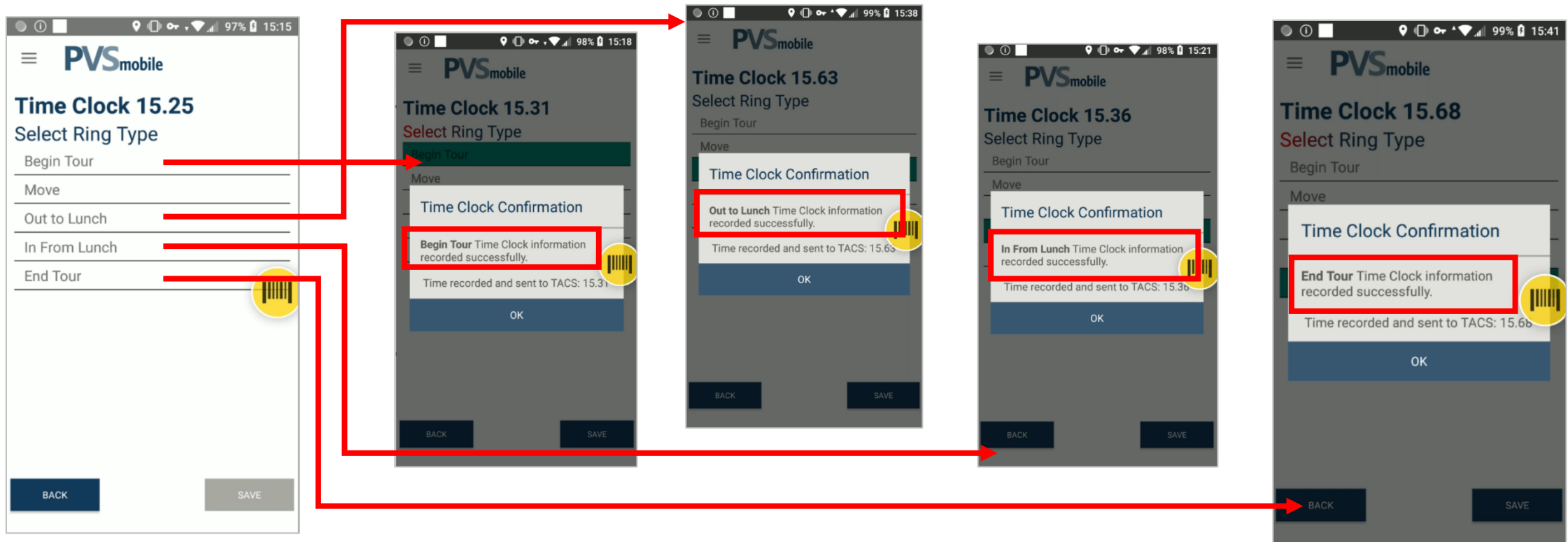

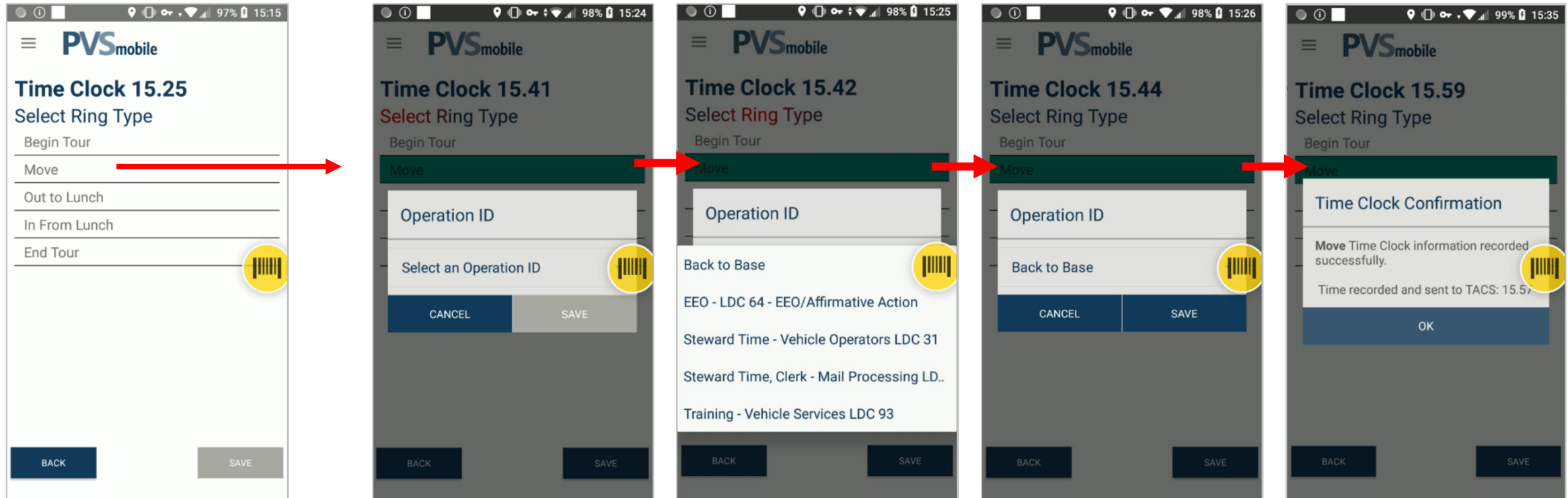

Ensuring Scanner is Updated

Please ensure your scanners have received the update using the below steps:



Enter PVSmobile, verify that application version 3.8.0-0 displays at the bottom of the login screen, log into PVSmobile.



Open the Navigation Menu and select Settings, select Device Information.



Scroll to the bottom of the Device Information screen, verify that PVS displays application version 3.8.0-0 and CSS displays version 2.5.0-0.
