As a matter of general interest, the Postal Service plans to extend access to the USPS Health Connect Portal to all career non-bargaining employees who are veterans.

As you were previously informed in our October 20, 2017, correspondence, this online application provides employees with the ability to establish a personal online health records profile, which enables them to easily and securely collect, store and manage their health records. Further, it provides employees private and secure control and access to their records, as well as the distribution of that data.

Veterans who use this system will be able to send their United States Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) health summary from the VA patient portal (*MyHealthVet*) to the USPS Health Connect Portal through a secure direct messaging address.

The USPS Health Connect Portal is currently available to all Headquarters career non-bargaining employees. We anticipate extended access to the application will be available by the end of February.
