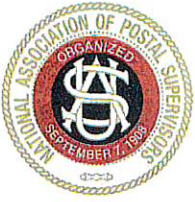
This is in reference to our proposal concerning revisions to the EAS salary schedule effective January 5, 2019 detailed in our December 14 correspondence.



The Postal Service proposes revision of the current Executive and Administrative (EAS) Salary Schedule.

The Postal Service is proposing to increase the maximum salary range by 1.6 percent and the minimum salary range adjusted based on the dollar increase to the respective level maximum. We are proposing this change to be effective January 5, 2019.

Employee salaries will be adjusted within their respective salary ranges based on individual performance determinations in accordance with the Pay-For-Performance. Employee salaries would be brought to the minimum prior to making Pay-for-Performance salary related adjustments.

The enclosed proposed revision is furnished for your review outside of the pay consultation process of Title 39 § 1004.
