Board Memo 166-2024: High Winds & Tornado Damage at The Craig RMPO

Executive Board,

NAPS headquarters received information from the USPS regarding high winds and tornado damage that occurred at the Craig RMPO in Craig, MO on October 30th.

Central Area

KS-MO District

Situation – The Craig RMPO sustained damage from a high winds/tornado storm event that moved through the KS-MO District today. A support column near the entrance to the facility was damaged/dislodged. FSSP contacted to request structural inspection/assessment. The facility will be closed until assessment and/or repairs can be completed. The office will temporarily COOP out of the Fairfax RMPO.

Craig RMPO, Craig MO 64437 (Level 4 Hour).

- No injuries reported
- FMO assistance requested in relocating carrier case

Property:

- Support column at main entrance damaged/dislodged
- Emergency FSSP Ticket #45224520 has been opened requesting emergency assessment and repairs
- Facility will closed until assessment/repairs are completed.
- Facility will temporarily COOP out of the **Fairfax RMPO, Fairfax MO 64446**

Product:

- Retail Operations are closed/retail customers directed to the Fairfax RMPO
- PO Box area is closed/PO Box customers directed to the Fairfax RMPO
- Delivery Operations are relocated to the Fairfax RMPO
- Impacted mail has been removed from areas of flooding and staged in a location to dry out

- District Communications Specialist has been informed
- Notice has been posted at the entrance to inform customers
- Unions will be informed of the event
- FSSP Ticket #45224520 has been opened for emergency repairs
- PANs entry will be created.
