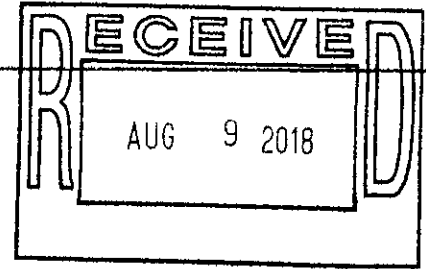

Dear Brian:

As a matter of general interest, the Postal Service plans to implement a new assessment for applicants seeking employment into certain entry level, bargaining unit positions. This new assessment will be used for four job categories and the assessment will replace Battery Examination 473.

Implementation of the new assessment will begin in August for applicants to the following jobs:

The new assessment has a separate version for each of the following job clusters: Carrier, Mail Handler, Customer Service Clerk and Mail Processor. Each version contains the same core content but also includes content specific to the designated job.

Bargaining unit career employees who are on the rolls at the point of implementation of the new entry level assessment and who have a qualifying score on the 473 Battery Examination, will be considered qualified for the above-referenced positions for the purposes of the entrance examination. Also, once hired, employees who qualify on any version of the new assessment will be considered qualified on all versions for the purposes of voluntary or involuntary reassignment.
