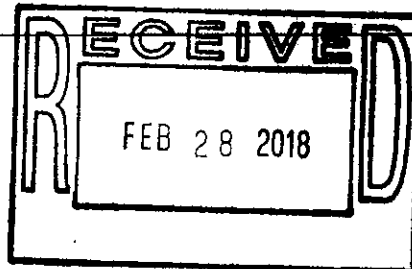

Dear Brian:

This is in further reference to our October 16, 2016 notice concerning a new parcel sorter machine - Automated Delivery Unit Sorter (ADUS).

We are expanding the test to include use of a smaller version of the ADUS sorter system. The test is scheduled to begin the week of March 12, at the Sully Station in Centerville, Virginia (20120).

The sorter, for this version of the test will only have 40 sort bins. This machine is designed to decrease the time required to scan and distribute packages. During this phase of the test, packages will be scanned and sorted across the ADUS and distributed into a variety of mail transport equipment.

We plan to use the test results to help determine the efficiency of the modified machine and the possibility of future expansion.
