This is in further reference to our July 14, 2017, notice concerning testing smart sensor and camera technology in Promaster, Flex Fuel and Long Life Vehicles.

We plan to expand the subject test to incorporate cameras and a Global Positioning System (GPS) device for the purpose of detecting and reporting road conditions. The test will be conducted in the South Columbus, Ohio (43207); Buford, Georgia (30518); and Lawrenceville, Georgia (30046) offices. The test's purpose is to evaluate business potential and develop costing and work requirements.

The test will be conducted November 4 through November 17. During this period participating carriers will operate test vehicles while performing their street duties.
