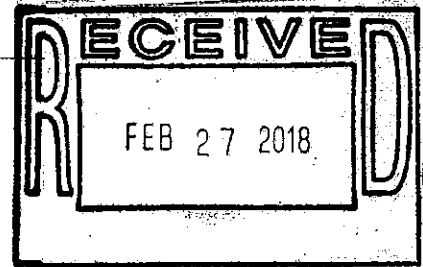

Dear Brian:

As a matter of general interest, the Postal Service intends to test the use of computer monitors in four Promaster vehicles at the Shirlington Carrier Annex in Arlington, Virginia (22206).

The monitors will be installed in the Promaster's dashboard and display the MDD screen when the device is cradled in the vehicle. Additionally, audio from the MDD will play through the vehicle's sound system. The test vehicles will be operated by a variety of letter carriers.

We anticipate that the test monitors will improve the use of turn by turn navigation.

The test is planned for two weeks beginning March 11 through March 25.
