Dear Mr. Wagner:

As a matter of general interest, the Postal Service will be partnering with Atmos Digital Incorporated to test a single unit system and a multi-unit array system that are designed to provide for delivery of packages into a secure but unattended mail receptacle.

The USPS continues to seek alternative options to deliver packages to our customers in an efficient and secure manner. The Atmos systems have three locker access modes. Carriers can access lockers via the last 4 digits of the USPS tracking number, by utilizing a Bluetooth connection pilot supplied device or by accessing the locker via a QR barcode pre-affixed by the shipper.

The test is tentatively scheduled to begin June 28 and run for approximately six months.

The Atmos systems will be tested in Ogden, Utah at the following addresses (six residential addresses listed below and 1 commercial address still to be determined):
