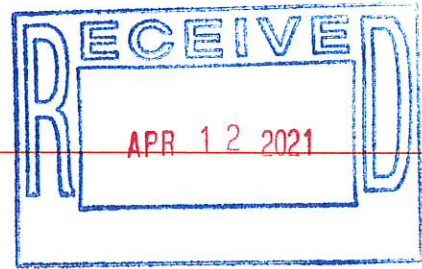

Dear Brian:

As a matter of general interest, the Postal Service intends to test an Auto Feed system on the Delivery Bar Code System (DBCS) with DBCS Input-Output Subsystem (DIOSS).

Technologically Enhanced Ledge Loading Systems (TELLS) is a Sortation Systems Technology (SST) initiative designed to automate the feed system process of the Postal Service's letter processing machines. The system is designed to automatically remove, upright, and transition letters from Extended Managed Mail (EMM), Managed Mail (MM), and ½ size letter trays to the feed ledge of our automated letter sorting machines.

Employees currently working the equipment will assist by placing trays of letters into the Auto Feed component, removing empty trays, and sweeping the machines.

The subject test will begin May 3 in the Dulles, Virginia, Processing and Distribution Center (P&DC) for a duration of four weeks. Installation of the TELLs equipment will begin no sooner than April 19.
