Board Memo 004-2025: Update on Wildfires in California

Executive Board,

NAPS headquarters has received an update on the wildfires currently affecting California. The update is as of today, January 14, 2025.

Situation:

National Preparedness is currently monitoring active wildfires across three (3) districts (California 3, 4, and 5) – to include Air Quality via EPAs Airnow.gov.

Critical Fire Weather Conditions will continue with moderate to locally strong Santa Ana winds through Wednesday. These winds combined with dry air and dry vegetation will keep the fire weather threat in the area.

Wildfires:

1. Palisades Fire is 19,978 acres – 14% contained (Impacting California 3, 5 Districts)
2. Eaton Fire is 13,956 acres – 33% contained (Impacting California 3, 4 District)

The information below is current as of 1800 (eastern)

People:

- All employees remain safe and accounted for.
- Ninety-five (95) employees in three (3) districts and one division (California 3 – 16; California 4 – 35; California 5 – 36; and the Southern Cal – 8) have been evacuated from their homes due to the wildfire.
- Seventeen (17) employees in three districts and one division (California 3 – 2; California 4 – 8; California 5 – 5; and Southern Cal – 2) have lost their homes.

Property:

- Five (5) Offices in 2 districts (California 4 – 1 (including Altadena); and California 5 – 4) remain closed due to evacuation orders and road closures.
- Operations for three of these offices have been moved to alternate locations (COOP'ed):
 - Altadena Main Post Office (California 4 District) - Operations for this office have been moved to the Pasadena CA Post Office.
 - Palisades Post Office – Operations for this office have been moved to the Rancho Park Post Office until evacuation orders are lifted.
 - Topanga Post Office – Operations for this office have been moved to the Santa Monica Post Office until evacuation orders are lifted.
- Nine (9) of the 25 vehicles at the Altadena Post Office were salvageable.
- One (1) office resumed delivery today (Arcadia Post Office).

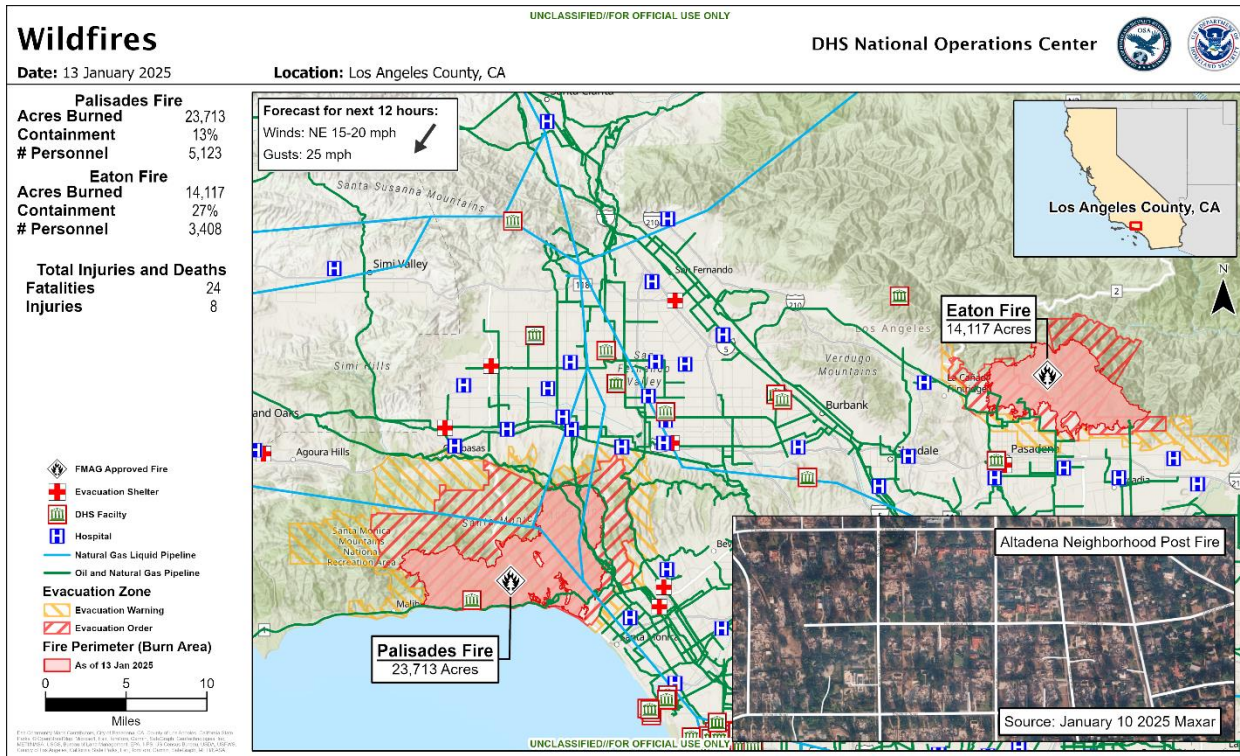
Product:

- Delivery impacts due to evacuation orders and road closures will be reported in Delivery Condition Visualization and Operational Impact Systems.

Communications:

- HQ/Area/Division/District Leadership are engaged.
- Industry Alerts have been posted and will be kept current.
- Unions and Management Associations are being briefed.
- National Preparedness
