Board Memo 023-2026: Super Typhoon Bavi

Executive Board,

NAPS headquarters has received the following information from the USPS regarding Super Typhoon Bavi.

Super Typhoon Bavi (with winds up to 180 mph and coastal inundation up to 12 feet) made its way through Guam/CNMI over the weekend and moved west-northwest away from coastal waters; the eyewall of the storm passed over the island of Rota. Guam, Rota, Tinian, and Saipan were all under Condition Readiness 1 (COR 1; shelter in place); Condition of Readiness (COR) 4, normal operations, was resumed July 7 (local time). All USPS Pre-Landfall checklists were completed before impact. Note that the response update from Rota has not yet been received; it is anticipated in the early evening, EDT.

At this time, all employees are safe and accounted for (post-impact) on Guam and Saipan. All employees (clerks, carriers, management) reported to work. No property or product damage was reported, and cleanup is complete, on Guam and Saipan.
