Board Memo 042-2025: Flooding in Kerr County and Hunt, Texas

Executive Board,

NAPS headquarters has received information from USPS regarding excessive rainfall and flooding that took place in Texas. This update was as of July 4, 2025.

Situation: Excessive rainfall with flash flooding prompted road closures in several areas of Kerr County, specifically Hunt, TX 78024 and Kerrville, TX 78028. Currently, one (1) office, Hunt Post Office 78024 (Main PO – Level 18), has been swept away by floodwaters (picture below). Delivery impacts expected in the Kerr County area due to road closures and flooding. A Flash Flood Emergency remains in effect and Flash Flood Warnings will continue through this evening for these same areas. Information is current as of 12:15PM (CT).

People:

1. All employees in both Kerrville TX and Hunt TX are reported as safe and accounted for.

Property:

2. Level 18 Facility washed away by floodwaters [Hunt Post Office, 1644 Highway 39, Hunt TX 780240]
 1. Facility ID: 1367644; reported as Leased
3. Assessments underway for what remains onsite

Product:

4. COOP for Retail and delivery (Hunt PO) will be finalized when full assessments can be made
5. Expected delivery impacts due to evacuation orders, road closures and flooding, severe weather
6. CPMS points will be unable to be scanned
7. Scanning impacts and delivery delays will be reported in DCV and FDB
