Board Memo 067-2025: Atmospheric River Impacts in California

Executive Board,

NAPS headquarters has received an update from the USPS regarding a major atmospheric river that has impacted California. See notice below.

A major atmospheric river has impacted California with high winds, heavy rain, mudslides, and significant snowfall in the Sierra Nevada. Currently, four (4) Districts (CA1, CA3, CA4, and CA6) and one (1) Division (Western) are experiencing the effects of this storm. The team has been dealing with impacts since Christmas Eve. Here is the current update:

- Six (6) offices *closed*:
 - CA2 – 1: due to winter conditions and road closures: Donner Finance station 96161
 - CA3 – 3: due to conditions and road closures
 - Lee Vining 93541, RMPO; Bridgeport 93517, Level 18; June Lake 93529, RMPO
 - CA6 – 2: being COOP'd
 - Wrightwood PO 92397 COOP'd to Phelan PO 92371 Level 20
 - Lytle Creek PO 92358 COOP'd to Fontana PO 92334 Level 24
- One (1) office *reopened*: CA4 – 1: Trabuco Canyon Finance Station 92678
- Two (2) facilities *open but* reporting roof leak or water in basement:
 - CA3 – 2 with water intrusion:
 - John Steinback 93901, Level 21; Mission Station 93401, Level 22
- Challenging I-80 road conditions continue to effect logistics between NV and Sacramento. 70 miles of maximum chain control remain in effect, with alternate routes enduring extreme weather. Reno plans launch of Sacramento trips the AM of 12/27/25
- Power restored to 25 of 28 offices in CA1 (3 sites remain without power – 95421, 95430, and 95456)
- Power restored to 4 of the 7 offices in CA3 (3 sites remain without power – 93950, 93953, and 93921)
