Dear Brian:

As a matter of general interest, the Postal Service is updating the label design for the Click-N-Ship application on USPS.com to include a marking that says "U.S. Postage Paid Click-N-Ship" in the upper right hand corner instead of the barcode.

The updated labels should be accepted and handled in the same manner as the existing Click-N-Ship labels. In addition, the existing postage barcodes generated on the labels are still valid. The updated labels may appear on all types of Click-N-Ship labels to include, Priority Mail Express®, Priority Mail®, First-Class Package Service®, First-Class Package International Service®, USPS Retail Ground®, Global Express Guaranteed®, Priority Mail Express International®, and Priority Mail International® labels.

Testing of the labels will begin in July and they will be released August 1. There are no changes to the acceptance process.

Updated Click-N-Ship Label Design Roll Out

The Click-N-Ship® application on Usps.com® is making updates to its label design. Beginning later this week, customers may present mailpieces containing labels bearing an updated marking in the upper right hand corner. These labels are legitimate Click-N-Ship® labels and should be accepted and handled the same as other Click-N-Ship® labels. **Also, labels with the existing evidence of postage barcodes will still be generated by Click-N-Ship® and are still valid for acceptance on mailpieces.**

Please be aware that the updated design may appear on all types of Click-N-Ship® labels such as Priority Mail Express®, Priority Mail®, First-Class Package Service®, First-Class Package International Service®, USPS Retail Ground®, Global Express Guaranteed®, Priority Mail Express International®, and Priority Mail International® labels.

This information is provided for awareness purposes only. The updated Click-N-Ship® labels require no special acceptance processes.
