As a matter of general interest, Cyclomedia Technology, Inc. and CamenAI will work with the Postal Service to conduct a pilot test to capture street imagery for the purpose of assisting local government entities in responding to non-emergency complaints, such as dumped garbage, overgrown weeds on public property, and other community cleanup efforts.

Cyclomedia Technology, Inc. is well known as an industry partner in capturing, collecting, and processing panoramic street level images. CamenAI is a European based company specializing in providing organizations with a digital platform and artificial intelligence capabilities to analyze photos and images. The strategy in this initiative is to leverage the Postal Service's unique ability to collect valuable data because of the scale and frequency our fleet of postal vehicles travel the roads in every community across the country.

The process of gathering data for this initiative includes mounting a smartphone inside the windshield of five Long Life Vehicles (LLVs) at the Fairfax, VA Post Office. The five LLVs equipped with the smartphones will be rotated throughout the forty-five routes in the office in an effort to collect data from the entire Fairfax, VA delivery area.

City and rural carrier employees' participation in this test will be limited to operating the modified postal vehicles during the performance of their regularly assigned street delivery duties. The pilot test is scheduled to begin August 20 and will last for a thirty-day period.

The Postal Service is excited to announce an initiative with Cyclomedia Technology, Inc. and CamenAI to pilot the capture of street imagery data to assist local government entities in responding to non-emergency complaints, such as dumped garbage and overgrown weeds on public property, and other community cleanup efforts.

Cyclomedia Technology, Inc. is well-known as an industry partner in capturing, collecting, and processing panoramic street level images. CamenAI is a European based company specializing in providing organizations with a digital platform and artificial intelligence capabilities to analyze photos and images. The strategy in this initiative is to leverage the Postal Service's unique ability to collect valuable data because of the scale and frequency with which our fleet of postal vehicles travel streets of every community across the country.

The process of gathering data for this initiative includes mounting a smartphone inside the windshield of five Long Life Vehicles (LLVs) at the Fairfax, VA Post Office. The five LLVs equipped with the smartphones will be rotated throughout the forty-five routes over the course of the next 30 days in order to collect imagery from the entire Fairfax, VA delivery area.

During this pilot the delivery employee is responsible for operating the postal vehicle on the assigned route's line of travel. No imagery data is collected from inside the postal vehicle at any time.

Thank you for your assistance with this pilot. The device may lead to new revenue for the Postal Service and also help identify much needed improvements along your route. That will be advantageous for the Postal Service and the community.
