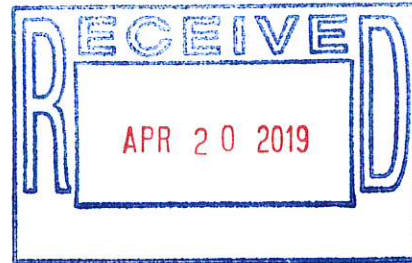

As a matter of general interest, the Postal Service has developed a strategic learning initiative regarding the Bank Secrecy Act (BSA). This training program is titled *Suspicious Transactions Recognition*.

The BSA is the primary law that governs organizational responsibilities in the detection, prevention, and deterrence of money laundering. The *Suspicious Transactions Recognition* training was developed to educate Sales and Services Associate employees in recognizing and reporting suspicious transactions which may be linked to criminal activity.

Implementation of the *Suspicious Transactions Recognition* training is expected to begin April 17.
