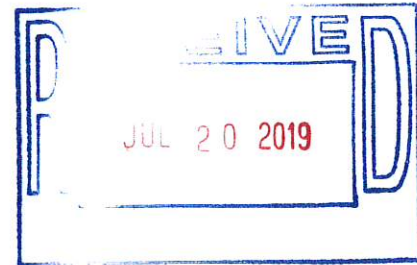

Dear Brian:

This is in further reference to our January 25, 2017, notice concerning the Postal Service's intent to establish dual casing (2 in 1 casing) in certain delivery units.

The subject notice indicated that a single carrier case will be used to case two routes each day, with the carriers' starting time staggered to allow for single use of the casing equipment.

In a meeting held with the NALC at Postal Service Headquarters on February 8, 2018, we discussed with the national union the fact that the 2 in 1 casing process had been used in the field for several years prior to our January 25 notice. Furthermore, we clarified that the purpose of our January 25 correspondence was to advise the union of further implementation starting with the sites indicated therein.
