This letter is in further reference to the notice dated June 24, 2022 (enclosed), regarding the Postal Service's partnership with the General Services Administration (GSA) to provide a single sign-on solution called 'Login.gov' that allows the public to use the same username and password to access various federal government websites. The Postal Service is expanding the In-Person Proofing (IPP) service for Identity Assurance Level 2 (IAL2) customers to select locations.

As previously informed, this partnership continues to provide an efficient, economical and secure structure to support GSA's needs. Many of the applications or services on federal government websites require the public to log in and register in order to visit the website. This GSA partnership utilizes the existing IPP process for Login.gov registrants. Login.gov allows registrants to use one login account for secure access to participating federal government agencies.

The IPP IAL2 will allow participating federal government agencies to securely verify customer identities in person as an alternative when they cannot be verified through the online portal. Customers may opt for IPP IAL2 at select locations with no appointment or payment required. Customers will need to provide an acceptable primary and secondary form of identification.

The expansion is scheduled to begin July 29, retail employees will be trained prior to the launch date. Enclosed is the Retail Service Talk that includes the pilot site locations by Area, District and site.

As a matter of general interest, the Postal Service is partnering with the General Services Administration (GSA) to provide a single sign-on solution called 'Login.gov' that will allow the public to use the same username and password to access various federal government websites. This partnership builds upon the existing relationship with GSA to provide an efficient, economical and secure structure that supports GSA's needs.

Many of the applications or services on federal government websites require the public to log in and register in order to visit the website. This GSA partnership will utilize the existing In-Person Proofing (IPP) process for Login.gov registrants. Login.gov will allow registrants to use one login account for secure access to participating federal government agencies.

The Postal Service will provide IPP service to customers who seek to register on Login.gov. Retail employees will use the Retail Systems Software (RSS) terminal to enter and verify the customer's information, once completed the customer will receive an email with the steps to access Login.gov.

The subject program is scheduled to be piloted beginning July 27. Retail employees will be trained beginning the week of July 11.

Enterprise Biometric Identity Services (EBIS)

Login.gov In-Person Proofing (IPP) Identity Assurance Level 2 (IAL2) Pilot



In July, USPS — in collaboration with Login.gov — will expand In-Person Proofing (IPP) services for Identity Assurance Level 2 (IAL2) customers. The pilot will be available in 23 retail locations that use the Enterprise Biometric Identity Service (EBIS) tablet to process these types of transactions. This new service allows agencies to securely verify customer identities in person and provide an alternative when identity cannot be substantiated with remote proofing approaches. Offering this service will allow USPS to become a trusted "go-to" provider for inperson proofing IAL2 services.

Customers may receive In-Person Proofing IAL2 at any of the 23 USPS EBIS retail pilot locations with no appointment needed or transaction payment. Customers will be expected to provide two (2) acceptable non-expired Strong ID Types and up to two (2) Fair ID Types.

Here are the acceptable types:

Strong ID Types

- · State Driver's License
- State Non-Driver's Identification Card
- Uniformed Services Identification Card
- Passport
- Passport Card

Fair ID Types

- Lease, Mortgage, or Deed of Trust
- Voter Registration Card
- Vehicle Registration Card
- Home or Vehicle Insurance Policy

The customer must also provide two (2) acceptable forms of Fair ID if any of the following is true:

- The customer's acceptable form of Strong ID does not include the customer's address
- The address listed on the Strong ID is incorrect
- Only one (1) non-expired form of Strong ID has been presented
