As a matter of general interest, the Postal Service has added a Federal Employees' Group Life Insurance Program (FEGLI) module to PostalEASE. The subject module will allow employees to enroll in FEGLI or reduce their FEGLI coverage.

Elections made as a result of a Qualifying Life Event must still be submitted through Standard Form 2817, *Life Insurance Election* to the Human Resource Shared Service Center.

We have enclosed screenshots of the new FEGLI module.

#### Welcome to the Federal Employees' Group Life Insurance Application

This module is for enrolling in or making certain changes to your Federal Employees' Group Life Insurance (FEGLI).

To be eligible for FEGLI, you must be a career employee.

All career employees are automatically enrolled in Basic life insurance. This module will allow you to elect additional (Optional) coverage or to waive some or all of your coverage at any time.

If you are a new career Postal Service employee with no prior Postal (or federal) service, you may elect Optional coverage within 60 days of the enter-on-duty date found on your PS Form 50, Notice of Personnel Action. If you are converting to career, you may elect Optional coverage within 60 days of your career appointment date. You must have Basic coverage in order to enroll in Optional coverage. For most employees, Basic coverage is fully paid by the Postal Service; however, you have the option to waive Basic coverage.

If you have prior Postal or federal service and you have had a break in service of 180 days or more, you may change your previous election.

Note that you cannot have Optional insurance without Basic coverage. Additional FEGLI information may be found at <a href="https://liteblue.usps.gov/fegli">https://liteblue.usps.gov/fegli</a>.

Employees may reduce or waive life insurance coverage at any time unless coverage has been assigned.

If you have a Qualifying Life Event such as marriage, divorce, spouse's death, or the acquisition of an eligible child, and wish to enroll or increase your coverage, you must submit a completed SF2817, Life Insurance Election Form, to the HRSSC with supporting documentation. Contact the Human Resources Shared Service Center at 1-877-477-3273 for the form or visit <a href="https://liteblue.usps.gov/fegli">https://liteblue.usps.gov/fegli</a>. Mail your QLE request to the HRSSC at PO Box 970400 Greensboro NC 27497-0400.

At the end of the transaction, you will receive a confirmation number along with information regarding when your election will become effective. Elections submitted during business hours will typically be processed the following day. Please print a copy for your records and refer to this confirmation number if you should have any questions.

If you are unable to enroll or make an enrollment change, please contact the Human Resources Shared Service Center (HRSSC) at 1-877-477-3273 (a), option 5; Federal Relay Service 1-800-877-8339 (a). An alternative to the online system is to make your election through *PostalEASE* IVR by calling 1-877-477-3273 (a), option 1.

#### **FEGLI Open Season Dates**

FEGLI Open Seasons are rare and will be announced by the Office of Personnel Management (OPM).
