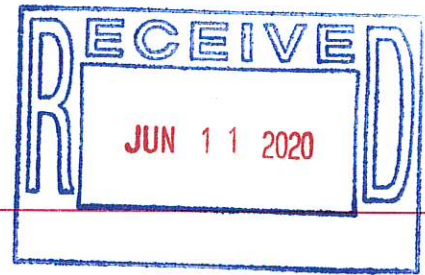

Dear Brian:

As a matter of general interest, the Postal Service plans to test a new Long Life Vehicle (LLV) Barrier Solution for driver training during COVID-19 pandemic.

As the COVID-19 pandemic continues to spread, the U.S. Postal Service continues to provide a vital public service that is part of the nation's critical infrastructure. As such, the need for training of new delivery drivers has been hindered by social distancing requirements. The Postal Service will be testing a new solution to minimize driver and instructor contact.

This test will consist of developing a barrier, frame, and fan installation instructions for a plastic partition in the LLV cab, which would divide the cab into two sections, therefore minimizing the contact and risk of spreading the virus.
