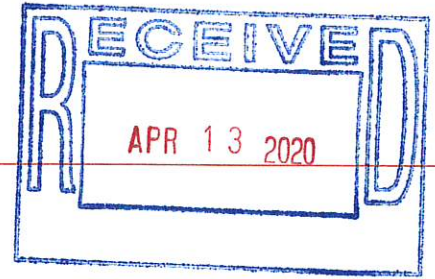

Release 7.15 includes:

- Custom Intercept in Package Look Ahead
- Aviation Security Survey

MDD Release 7.15 - Carriers

MDD Release 7.15 is scheduled for national deployment on April 22. New features introduced in this release include:

1. Custom Intercept in Package Look Ahead

Background

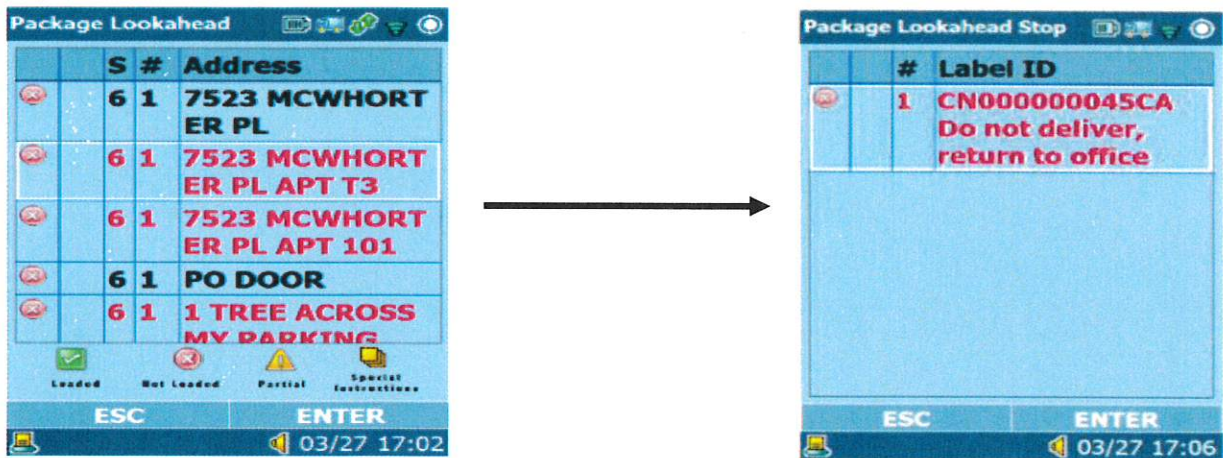
There is a need to highlight any packages that the carrier has in possession for delivery that appear on the customs intercept list. This is required to improve the capture rate of customs hold pieces.

Changes on MDD

Modify MDD to include customs intercept packages for the carrier's route in the package look ahead list. Those packages shall be highlighted in the PLA with the ability to display a message "Do Not Deliver Return to the Office".

If the customs intercept packages are intercepted through the load truck process, they will not be displayed again in package look ahead list. But if there is a need to display them again the application can do via a configuration setting change.

1. MDD highlights the Customs Intercept packages in red in package look ahead after distribution completion scan



MDD displays the address with customs intercept packages in RED. Select the stop for package details

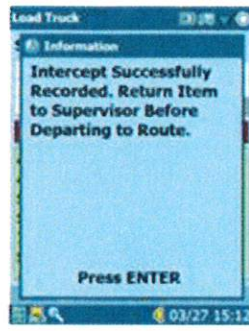
MDD displays the package label along with "Do Not deliver, return to office" message.

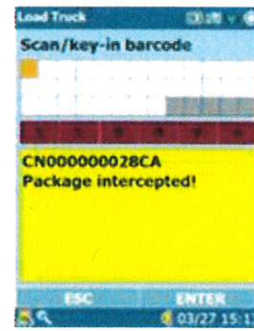
- MDD intercept Customs Intercept packages in Load Truck. Intercepted Customs intercept packages will not be displayed again in package look ahead list.

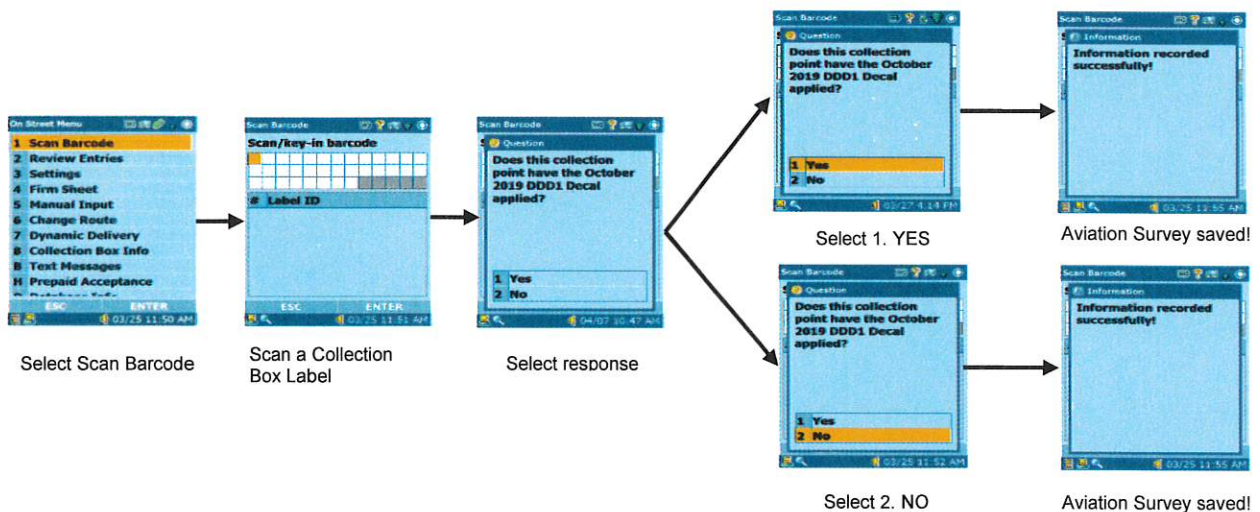
2. Aviation Security Survey

Background

The Aviation Security/Anonymous Mail Program was updated with new restrictions to better promote the safety and security of all Postal Service employees, customers and transportation networks.

Changes on MDD

When the blue collection box label is scanned, MDD pops up a survey question with Yes/No option to validate all DDD1 labels on the box. The survey question only pops up once upon the 1st time scan.



If the collection box label happens to be associated with a SPM request, upon scanning the collection box label the survey question pops up first, after the Yes/No response is received, SPM work order will be presented.
