NAPS Responds to USPS Motion to Dismiss Lawsuit

On November 20, 2019, the National Association of Postal Supervisors filed a rebuttal to the Postal Service's motion to dismiss NAPS's lawsuit against the Postal Service in the U.S. District Court in Washington, D.C.

NAPS's lawsuit seeks an order to require the Postal Service to pay its supervisors, managers, and other professional and administrative employees in accordance with federal law, which, among other things, requires compensation comparable to the private sector and requires an adequate differential in pay between supervisors and the craft employees they supervise. NAPS also asked the court to overturn the Postal Service's refusal to recognize the rights of postmasters and headquarters and area personnel to be represented by NAPS.

The Postal Service is expected to reply to NAPS's opposition sometime next month. NAPS will faithfully continue to pursue all avenues available to enforce its right to represent the best interests of all EAS members, including postmasters.
