As a matter of general interest, starting on July 18, the Postal Service will begin the Network Design Test. This test is expected to last for approximately 6 months.

During the Network Design Test, the Postal Service will extend the reach of our overnight network for Priority Mail products. We will be testing our ability to operationally execute a 1-day service standard for Priority Mail within 150 miles of an originating plant to a destinating delivery unit. This program is designed to increase the Postal Service's ability to compete within the marketplace.

The test will be limited to approximately 3,000 originating 3-digit to destinating 5-digit pairs from the following 5 originating sites:

- Oshkosh, WI
- Fresno, CA
- Jackson, MS
- Austin, TX
- Oklahoma City, OK

This initiative will not change the current methods by which employees process Priority Mail.
