Dear Brian:

As a matter of general interest, the Postal Service plans to pilot test a new centralized delivery box called "NeighborPost" in the Capital, Northern Virginia, and Sierra Coastal Districts.

The NeighborPost units provide larger compartments than traditional Cluster Box Unit (CBU) and are designed to increase successful first attempt package delivery.

The initial units will be installed at select delivery locations in the following units:
