After carefully considering the relevant factors under Article 32 of the National Agreement, the Postal Service has made the decision to contract with a third-party to prepare postal vehicles for sale at the end of service life.

One of the most important aspects of maintaining an operationally efficient fleet management program is to ensure the timely and consistent disposal of vehicles that have reach the end of service life as a part of the Postal Service fleet. Every postal owned vehicle requires some degree of "depostalization" as it is prepared for sale. This includes the removal of all USPS-identifying decals and equipment from the vehicles prior to sale.

We do not anticipate any significant impact to the bargaining unit.
