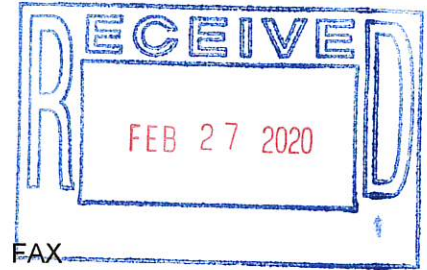

Dear Brian:

As a matter of general interest, the Postal Service will be conducting a Mobile Delivery Device (MDD) Misdelivery Alert test.

During the test management will be required to enter "Misdelivery Alerts" into the RIMS system for routes with customer complaints. These alerts will be transmitted to the carrier's MDD daily via a RIMS notification.

Testing will occur in the following locations:

- WDC Section 02 Carrier Annex, Washington, DC, 20002
- WDC Section 09 Carrier Annex, Washington, DC, 20009
- Woodbridge Main, Woodbridge, VA, 22191
- Franconia Station, Alexandria, VA, 22304

The test is scheduled to begin Saturday, February 29 and run for approximately 6 months. During this period, participating carriers will need to acknowledge receipt of the alerts.
