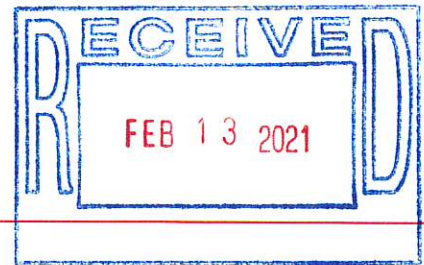

Dear Brian:

As a matter of general interest, the Postal Service plans to implement Virtual Managed Service Points (VMSP) in the Delivery Management System (DMS).

VMSPs will provide near real time data of identified locations with the ability to observe when the locations have been serviced and include documented time stamps. On the day of implementation, the current MSPs listed in the Delivery Operations Information System (DOIS) program will migrate to the DMS platform and become the initial VMSPs.

The current manual city delivery process of requesting, printing and physical scanning of street barcodes will cease upon ratification of the 2019 National Agreement between the National Association of Letter Carriers (NALC) and the United States Postal Service (USPS).

The new Virtual Managed Service Points are scheduled to be implemented on February 10, in all offices nationwide.
