Overview

1.0 Postage Payment Methods for First-Class Mail and First-Class Package Service — Retail

1.1 Payment Method

1.1.1 General

Except as provided under 1.1.2 for eligible First-Class Package Service-Retail business customers, Postage for single-piece First-Class Mail and First-Class Package Service — Retail must be paid with affixed postage stamps (604.1.0), postage evidencing system postage (604.4.0), or precanceled stamps (604.3.0).

1.1.2 First-Class Package Service-Retail Business Customers

In addition to the payment methods in 1.1.1, eligible First-Class Package Service-Retail business customers registered on USPS.com may pay postage with USPS Click-N-Ship.

1.0 Postage Payment Methods for First-Class Mail and First-Class Package Service — Retail

1.1 Payment Method

1.1.1 General

Except as provided under 1.1.2 for eligible First-Class Package Service-Retail business customers, postage for single-piece First-Class Mail and First-Class Package Service — Retail must be paid with affixed postage stamps (604.1.0), postage evidencing system postage (604.4.0), or precanceled stamps (604.3.0).

1.1.2 First-Class Package Service-Retail Business Customers

In addition to the payment methods in 1.1.1, eligible First-Class Package Service-Retail business customers registered on USPS.com may pay postage with USPS Click-N-Ship.
