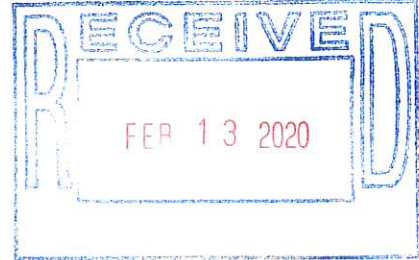

Dear Brian:

This is in further reference to our November 6, 2019, correspondence announcing the Postal Service's selection of the Zebra TC77 as the new on-street scanning device to replace the current Mobile Delivery Device (MDD).

The Postal Service has selected the offices below to serve as the First Article Test (FAT) pilot locations of the Zebra TC77. The FAT is scheduled to begin February 27.

- Fairfax Main Post Office - 10660 Page Avenue, Fairfax, Virginia 22030
- Dumfries Post Office - 17949 Main Street, Dumfries, Virginia 22026

National deployment is scheduled to begin in mid-March.

The new devices will have the same scanning capabilities as the current MDD.

In addition, as part of this deployment, some current MDDs will be repurposed as replacements for current Intelligent Mail Data Acquisition System (IMDAS) devices used by clerks for in-office operations.
