Dear Mr. Wagner:

As a matter of general interest, the Postal Service will be working with Ericsson, Inc. to test incorporating basic Android cell phones into Postal delivery vehicles for the purpose of detecting and mapping radio signal strength and quality.

The test will be conducted in the Golden Gate Post Office located at 3245 Geary Blvd, San Francisco, California 94118, to collect radio signal data on three Parcel Post/Relay routes in this facility.

The purpose of the test is to evaluate business potential and develop costing and work requirements. During this period, participating carriers will drive the test vehicles while performing their normal street duties. No carrier information will be collected during the test.

The test is scheduled to begin within the next 30 days and will continue for approximately 60 days.
