Dear Brian:

As a matter of general interest, the Postal Service will be partnering with Aclima, Inc. to test incorporating air quality sensors onto Postal delivery vehicles.

The purposes of this passive test is to determine if sensors mounted on Postal Service vehicles can detect and report environmental conditions including temperature, humidity, noise, light, and emissions like carbon dioxide and particulate matter.

The test is scheduled to be conducted in the Bay Valley District at the Civic Center and Piedmont Station in Oakland, California. The test will evaluate the business potential and costing and work requirements.

The test is scheduled to begin in September 7 and run for approximately 8 weeks. During this period, participating carriers will drive the test vehicles during the normal delivery of their routes. No carrier information will be collected during the test.
