As a matter of general interest, the Postal Service will be partnering with the Microsoft Corporation to test incorporating cameras, mobile LiDAR, and Global Positioning System (GPS) devices onto Postal delivery vehicles for the purposes of collecting street imagery and data on road conditions.

The test will be conducted in the Mountain View, California office (located at 1070 La Avenida Street, Mountain View, California 94043). The purpose of the test is to evaluate business potential and develop costing and work requirements.

The test is scheduled to begin in Mid-October and run for approximately 45 days. During this period participating carriers will operate their delivery vehicles (with the aforementioned devices) while performing their normal street duties.
