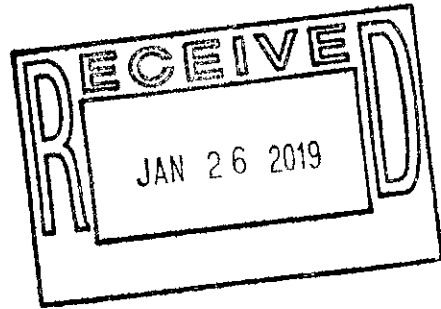

Dear Brian:

This serves as an update to our January 9, notice concerning the Office of Workers' Compensation's contract with *First Script* to provide the Pharmacy Benefit Manager (PBM) program for work related injuries.

Individuals covered by this program were divided into two groups. One group received a letter that use of the new benefits card would go into effect on February 1. The other group was scheduled to receive a letter that use of the new benefits card would go into effect on March 1.

However, a bid protest was filed with the U. S. Government Accountability Office. Consequently, in accordance with the Competition in Contracting Act, the latter group of employees will not receive notice of the program change until the protest has been adjudicated.

Employees who were sent the new benefit card will use the *First Script* program. Employees who were not mailed a new benefit card will continue to use the current program.
