Dear Mr. Butts:

This is in further reference to our August 8 communication related to the Postal Service piloting the Mobile Delivery Device (MDD) and Mobile Delivery Device - Technical Refresh (MDD-TR) as replacement devices for the Time and Attendance Collections System (TACS) on the Hyper Electronic Badge Reader (HEBR).

The Postal Service will be ending this pilot early, on November 12. All timekeeping entries should stop at end of day on November 12. The MDD timekeeping application will be kept live on the MDD until November 15 to ensure that all rings have successfully transmitted into TACS. On November 15, the application will be removed from the MDD. This will complete the MDD Carrier Timekeeping pilot.
