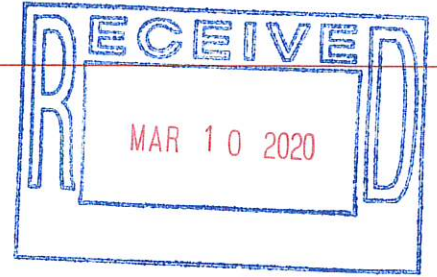

Dear Brian:

By letter dated February 7 you were notified that as a matter of general interest, the Postal Service will pilot a new program for Mail Delivery Notifications.

ZIP Codes 10036, 15701, 20002, 20009, 20747, 20874, 34481, 49651, 57108, 67846, 80521, and 92067 were originally targeted as sites for the pilot program scheduled to begin in March 2020. Zip Code 20817 has been added to the list as a pilot site.

Copies of the Retail and Carrier Standup talks for employees in the impacted ZIP Codes are enclosed.

### Mail Delivery Notification Pilot for Informed Delivery®

Informed Delivery was launched in 2017 as an optional, free feature that provides eligible residential and PO Box customers the ability to digitally preview their mail and manage incoming packages. To enhance Informed Delivery, as part of a pilot program we will be offering Mail Delivery Notification emails as an added feature that Informed Delivery users can choose to opt in to.

These optional Mail Delivery Notification emails will be sent to Informed Delivery pilot participants notifying them when letter and/or flat-sized mail has been delivered to the mailbox at their home address or to their PO Box. Please note that the Mail Delivery Notification emails are not providing an assurance that a specific mailpiece visible in a user's Informed Delivery daily digest email or dashboard has been delivered.

This new feature does not impact any delivery or scanning activities. Using the existing "Up" scan event entered in an Intelligent Mail Device (IMD) that signals that all PO Box mail is available, emails will then be sent to pilot participants. For residential deliveries, this notice will be provided by carrier Mobile Data Devices (MDDs) once a carrier leaves a particular ZIP+ 4 Code.

Starting in March 2020, USPS will pilot this new feature in select ZIP Codes™ within the United States. The pilot ZIP Codes include 10036, 15701, 20002, 20009, 20747, 20817, 20874, 34481, 49651, 57108, 67846, 80521, and 92067. Informed Delivery users in these ZIP Codes will be contacted via email to participate in the pilot and turn on Mail Delivery Notification emails.

Pilot participants can turn on these delivery notification emails by signing into their Informed Delivery account, selecting the "Settings" tab, and checking the box to turn on Mail Delivery Notification emails.

Through these delivery notification emails, USPS is providing our customers additional visibility into their mail delivery, while keeping mail relevant in an increasingly digital world.

### Mail Delivery Notification Pilot for Informed Delivery®

The pilot ZIP Codes include 10036, 15701, 20002, 20009, 20747, 20817, 20874, 34481, 49651, 57108, 67846, 80521, and 92067.
