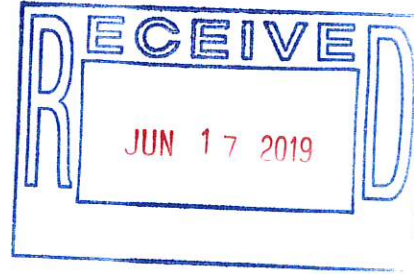

Dear Brian:

As a matter of general interest, the Postal Service plans to test video technology in select delivery vehicles in the Richmond and San Diego Districts.

The purpose of this test is to evaluate the feasibility of using video technology to collect information related to carrier street activities. The video technology used during the test will incorporate 360-degree external video cameras, internal video cameras, and GPS technology. Information obtained through the test equipment will assist in the validation of Delivery Street Review (DSR) data collected through the Mobile Delivery Device (MDD).

The following locations have been selected to participate in the test:

The test is scheduled begin June 17 and run for approximately 30 days. During this period, participating carriers will use test vehicles during the normal delivery of their routes.
