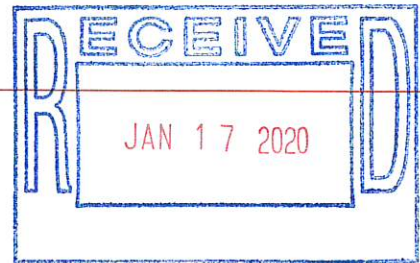

Dear Brian:

After carefully considering the relevant factors under Article 32 of the National Agreement, the Postal Service has made the decision to extend the outsourcing contract with a third-party to provide initial scanning and dumping of some import international mail volume arriving at the Los Angeles International Airport (LAX).

The contract will be extended through July 31, 2020. This will allow the Postal Service time to monitor any volume impacts caused by the Universal Postal Union (UPU) self-declared rate increase set to be published in April 2020, and made effective in July 2020. The extension will also afford the LAX International Service Center (ISC) ample time to make preparations and arrangements to return this work to in-house operations effective August 1, 2020.

No significant impact to the bargaining unit is anticipated.
