Your September 3 correspondence to Doug A. Tulino, Vice President, Labor Relations regarding the Postal Service's plans to resume the job analysis of several supervisor positions has been forwarded to this office for response.

Specifically, you recommended that the Postal Service include the positions of Supervisor Postal Police (OCC: 2335-0022) and Tour Supervisor Postal Police (OCC: 2335-0023) among the analysis.
