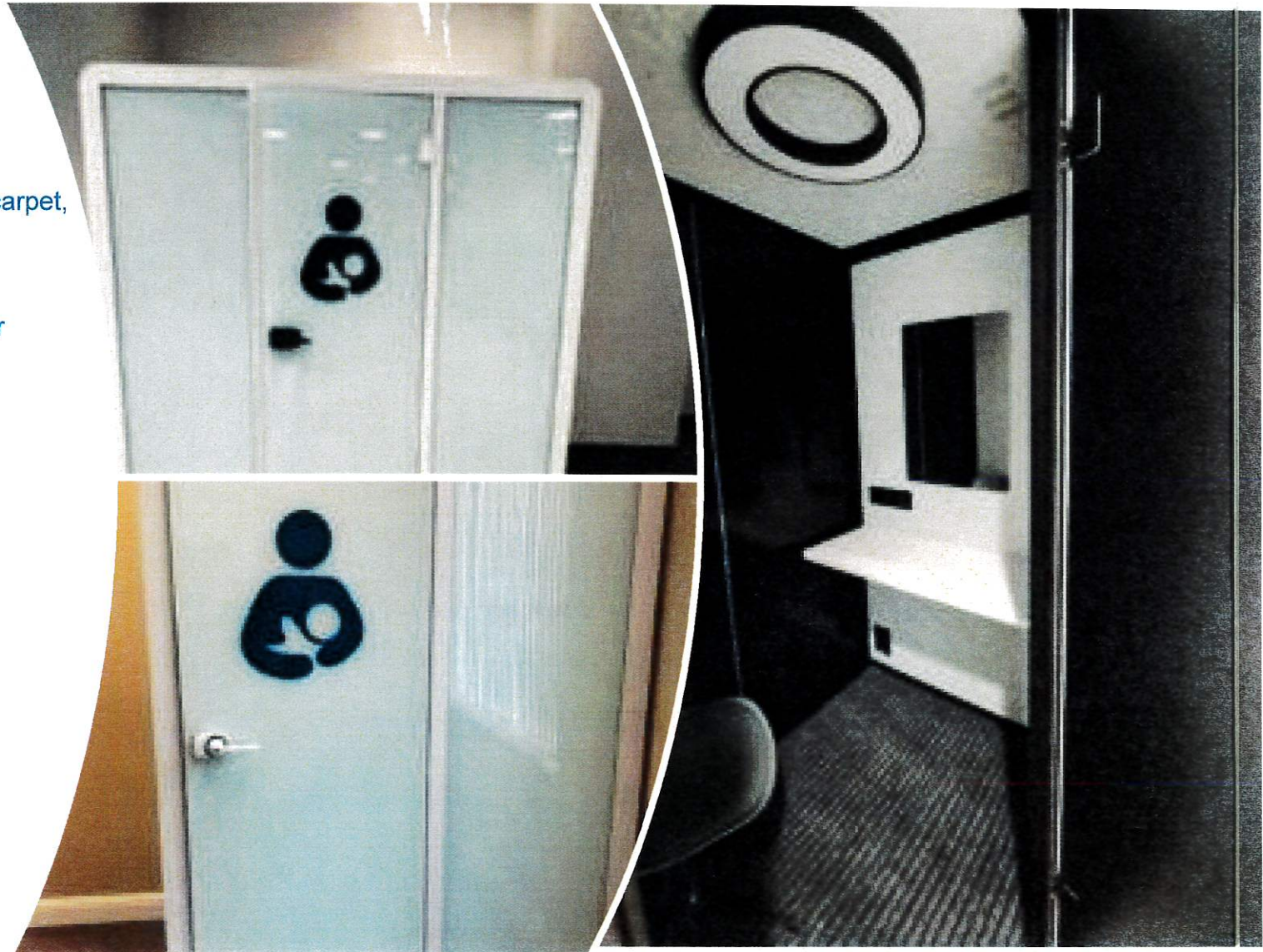
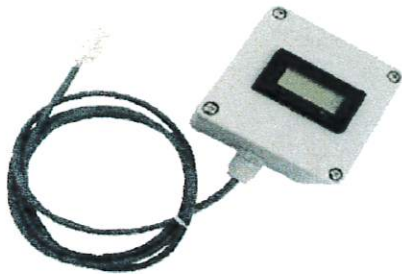

CLEANING YOUR LACTATION POD

BrighterBooth's lactation pods are low maintenance, only requiring general household preventative maintenance to keep the pod looking new.

- Schedule regular cleanings or include your pods in your custodial service's schedule.
 - Disinfect hard surfaces with non-corrosive, all purpose, standard household cleaning products like disinfectant wipes or spray.
 - Disinfect porous surfaces with non-corrosive, all purpose, standard household upholstery carpet cleaner or cleaning liquid.
 - Vacuum ventilation fan on ceiling to remove dust and debris.
 - Periodically dust the exterior roof of the pod to avoid dust accumulation.
- Communicate with staff emphasizing a group effort to help keep the pod clean.
 - Stock the pod's table with hand sanitizer and/or sanitizing surface wipes.
