As a matter of general interest, the Postal Service plans to revise the authorized staffing criteria for the position titled, Secretary (P7-07), Occupation Code: 0318-0004.

Due to the administrative restructure that occurred in 2021, the managerial positions that were previously supported by secretarial positions no longer exist, specifically, the District Managers of Finance, Marketing, and Operations Program Support. The revised criteria maintains support for managers of post office and plant operations and adds an authorized position as a direct report to the Manager, Customer Relations (District) under the Vice President, Customer Experience.
