This is in further reference to the Postal Service's prior correspondence concerning Sorting and Delivery Centers (S&DCs). As discussed in the October 31, 2023 correspondence, the purpose of creating S&DCs is to reduce transportation and mail handling costs as well as provide postal customers with additional services. S&DCs will allow for easier standardization and management of operations will have improved building and operating conditions for employees.

This notice is to provide further updated information on the sites scheduled for conversion into S&DCs planned to launch June 1, 2024.

The Postal Service originally scheduled the move of the Boston – Wollaston office into the Boston, Massachusetts S&DC, however, this office will not be moving. The Postal Service will move the Boston – East Weymouth office into the Boston, Massachusetts S&DC to launch on June 1, 2024:
